**Sub: Increase of the Honorarium of Mediators and Accreditation as Qualified Mediators.**

Dear Sir,

As per guidelines and suggestions of Mediation and Conciliation Project Committee Supreme Court of India, Hon'ble Acting Chief Justice and Executive Chairman, M.P.State Legal Services Authority is pleased to enhance the payment of Honorarium of the Mediators from 01.07.2013 till further order as shown below:

Nature of case	Honorarium
On settlement through mediation of a matrimonial case including criminal, custody, guardianship, probate, partition and possession	Rs.2500/- per case (with two or more connected cases, the maximum would be Rs.3500/
All other matters	Rs.1500/- per case(With two or more connected cases), the maximum would be Rs.2500/-
Connected case	Rs.500/- per case subject to a maximum of Rs.1000/- (regardless of the number of connected cases)
Cases not settled despite three effective sittings, as certified by the Coordinator of the Mediation Centre.	Rs.1000/-

The Mediation and Conciliation Project Committee Supreme Court has also decided to give accreditation to Mediators, who are working diligently to implement Mediation

practices in the Courts. I am bringing into your notice the following decisions of MCPC:-

*"The Committee has decided that henceforth only those persons who have completed at least 10 mediations resulting in a settlement and at least 20 mediations in all shall be accredited as qualified mediators. The Committee has further decided that those mediators accredited to the MCPC who have completed at least 50 mediations resulting in a settlement and at least 60 mediations in all shall be the eligible to undergo the TOT programme. A Committee has been constituted to prepare the curriculum, methodology and all other details for holding the TOT programme. Mediation Monitoring Committee may, therefore, be requested to identify the mediators who have completed mediation in the manner stated above to be eligible for accreditation and/or for undergoing TOT programme as the case may be."*

Therefore, you are requested to kindly bring above enhancement and Mediator Accreditation Scheme into notice of all concerned including District Mediation Coordinator, Mediators, Judges, Advocates, litigants of your district.
